

Rona Pondick was born in Brooklyn, New York in 1952. After studying at Queens College she obtained her Masters in Fine Arts at Yale University School of Art in 1977.

Pondick has been exhibiting since the mid-1980s and is well known for her site-specific sculpture installations and important solo and group exhibitions around the world. Her works are included in major museum collections as well as in private collections worldwide.
